EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

BCJ - Quarterly Monitoring & Compliance Report (April– June 2021)

During the period April to June 2021 five (5) Notices of Breach of Licence were issued to one (1) broadcast radio licensee, three (3) to broadcast television licensees and the other to a subscriber television licensee. There was an increase of three (3) when compared with the previous quarter, January to March–2021.

Forty (40) contacts were recorded for the period April – June 2021. Of this number, five (5) were complaints, which resulted in investigations of broadcast and television operators. Thirty-five (35) were queries and comments about other operational issues pertaining to licensed operators and the work of the Commission.

All five (5) complaints were matters relating to content standards. There was an increase of one (1) when compared with the previous quarter, January–March 2021.

There was no subscriber television technical inspection during the period under review.

In relation to the payment of the annual licence fee, fifteen (15) subscriber television (STVO's) operators, or 35% of all licensees paid in full; six (6) or 14% made partial payments and twenty-two (22) or 51% were non-compliant. There was no change in the number of full payments recorded when compared to the previous quarter. There was an increase of one (1) in number of licensees who made partial payments and there was a decrease of one (1) in the number of non-compliant licensees.

INTRODUCTION

Contacts with the Commission

Forty (40) contacts were recorded for the period, April – June 2021. There were five (5) content standard investigations and five (5) Notices of Breach of Licence.

PROGRAMMING CONTENT COMPLIANCE

The Commission investigated five (5) complaints relating to the broadcast of problematic content. The number of complaints investigated increased by one (1) when compared to the period January – March 2021.

Table 1 details the complaints investigated relating to content standards between April to June, and the nature of the investigations conducted by the Commission.

Figure 1 illustrates the trend in programming standard complaints investigated in similar reporting periods since 2018.

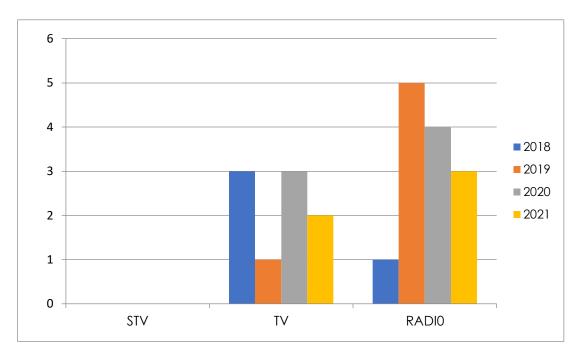

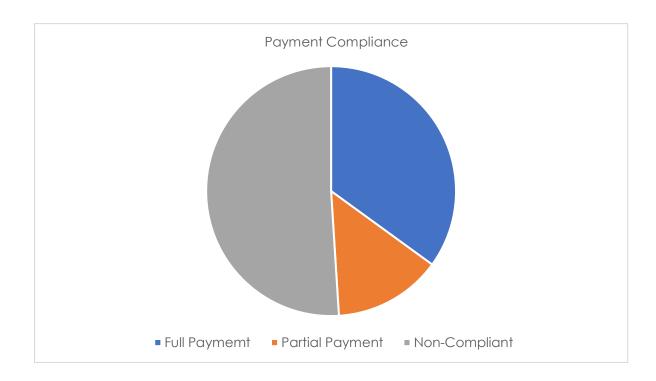

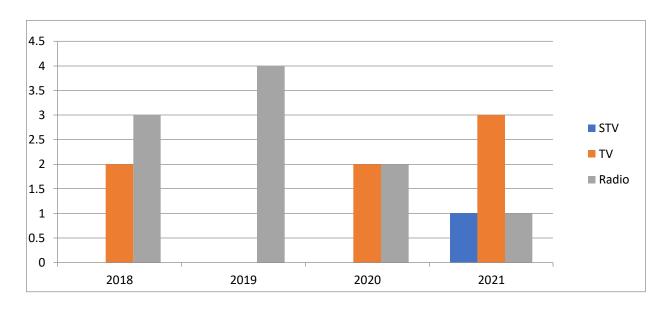
